Item: OPP PPSAP Agreement for 911 Services

Recommendation: Be It Resolved That: Bylaw No. 3219/24 be adopted, being a bylaw to enter into an agreement with OPP for Primary PSAP Services.

Background:

The municipality entered into an agreement with OPP to provide Primary Public Safety Answering Point Services following the disbandment of the Espanola Municipal Police. The agreement is up for renewal.

Analysis: The P-PSAP service is a necessary requirement of providing 9-1-1 to the public as it is the first point of contact when dialing 9-1-1; operators determine whether the caller requires police, fire or ambulance service before routing the call to the appropriate agency. OPP will always be the agency to dispatch police.

There is no increase to the rate for services compared to the current agreement, that being \$0.561/capita/annum. The annual cost of the service will be \$2908.79.
